


Q1: Are you 18 years of age or older?


Q2: What is your primary affiliation with Ashland University?
















Q10: How well do people at Ashland University understand you as a person?


Q11: How connected do you feel to the staff at Ashland University?


Q12: How welcoming have you found Ashland University to be?


Q13: How much respect do other employees at Ashland University show toward you?


Q14: How enriching is your experience at Ashland University?


Q15: Overall, how much do you feel like you belong at Ashland University?




Q17: If yes, how useful did you think the training was?


Q19: How likely is it that you would take action if you observed a situation you believe was, or could have led to, sexual misconduct?












Q26: Since 2015, have you experienced intimate partner violence?


Q27: Since the start of the current academic year, have you observed a situation involving others on campus that you believe was -- or could have led to -- sexual misconduct?






Q30: How likely do you think it is that other employees at Ashland University would intervene if they witnessed sexual misconduct or intimate partner violence?
