2. Students majoring in English may add a major in Creative Writing with 18 semester hours added to their curriculum, the same as a minor.

3. This curriculum guide allows for 51 credits of electives that may be used toward a minor, double major, or both. You may use more elective credits depending on the program(s) that you pair with the English major.
